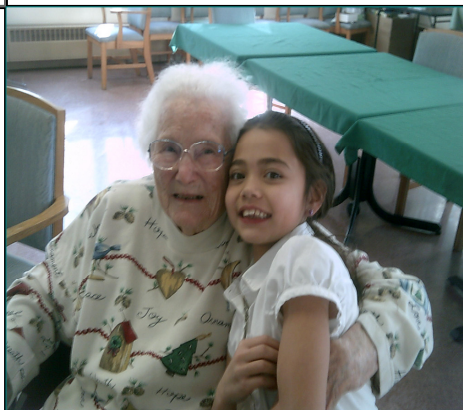
On January 26th the OVCS Knights played against Central Maine Academy. They won the game with a score of 38 to 21. Congratulations Knights on a job well done.
